



CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

Participation in the Traunsee Half Marathon is at your own risk. Minimum age is 18 years. Upon receipt of the starting numbers, each participant bindingly declares that there are no health concerns against participation. The organizer, its representatives and vicarious agents are not liable for personal injury, property damage or financial loss of any kind. This also applies to accidents, lost items of clothing and other objects, as well as the faultless functioning of the timekeeping system. It is not possible to withdraw from the registration if you are unable to attend or do not participate in the event. There is no entitlement to a refund of the entry fee. Changes are possible until the entry deadline on Wednesday, 18.6.2025 for a processing fee. The number of participants is limited. Places will be allocated according to the time of registration ("first come, first served"). The organizer is entitled to change the event for whatever reason or to cancel it for important reasons. In such cases, there is no entitlement to reimbursement of the entry fee and no obligation on the part of the organizer to pay compensation to the participant.

By registering, the participant agrees to the automatic storage and processing of personal data for the purpose of organizing the event. Furthermore, the participant agrees that the photos, film recordings and interviews made in connection with participation in the event may be distributed, published or used and passed on to third parties without remuneration claims in radio, television, print media, books, photomechanical reproductions (films, DVDs, etc.) as well as the data specified in the registration. The participant also agrees to receive newsletters and information from the organizer and from Traunsee Half Marathon partners. The participant has the right at any time to request the correction, updating and/or partial or complete deletion of his/her personal data by sending an e-mail to datenschutz@inovent.at. In the event of a request to this effect, the organizer will ensure that the data is deleted without delay. The participant also has the right to obtain information about the personal data stored by the organizer at any time.

The instructions of the police and stewards must be followed at all times. The organizer reserves the right to reject registrations, exclude participants from the start or disqualify them for good cause. Disqualification will occur in particular if the allocated start number is passed on to third parties, altered in any way, the advertising print made invisible or unrecognizable. The same applies to actions that disrupt the orderly course of the event or endanger the safety of other participants. Disqualified participants will not be allowed to start in the following two years.

The event will take place in all reasonable weather conditions. Typesetting and printing errors reserved. Place of jurisdiction is Gmunden/Austria.
